Items at each address are limited to one pile no larger than 2-feet wide by 3-feet high by 8-feet long, PLUS one bulky item such as a couch, mattress and box springs, recliner, etc. For pickup of garbage in excess of these guidelines, call Jendro's at 641-228-3525. There WILL be a fee for any excess items over these guidelines.

This is the 22nd year the City has joined forces with Jendro Sanitation Services for Spring Cleanup. Collections will start on **Monday, April 24<sup>th</sup>** and will continue through **Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup>**. **One pass per residence.** Please place items you wish to discard on the curb by 5 A.M. on Monday, April 24th. **DO NOT PLACE ITEMS FOR PICKUP IN THE ALLEY. DO NOT** place items out on the curb before **Saturday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>**. If you place items on the curb before April 22<sup>nd</sup>, you **WILL** be cited for a nuisance violation.

**\*\*BOX SPRINGS AND MATTRESSES WILL BE PICKED UP CITYWIDE MONDAY, the 24<sup>th</sup>\*\***

**During Spring Cleanup the following items WILL be collected with no cost to the homeowner.**

- 1) **Furniture & household items.** (Excludes TV's, computer equipment & major appliances. See back for information on disposal of those items.)
- 2) **Minor home remodeling debris,** must be bagged, boxed or bundled, no longer than four-feet (4') in length and each bag, box or bundle must weigh less than fifty (50) pounds. **Shingles, tarpaper or similar roofing materials WILL NOT be collected.**
- 3) **Paint cans containing dry paint** with the lid removed.
- 4) **Items at each address are limited to a pile no larger than 2-feet by 3-feet by 8-feet, PLUS one bulky item such as a couch, mattress and**

box spring, recliner etc. There WILL be a charge for excess items above these guidelines. Please contact Jendro Sanitation at 641-228-3525 to pick up excess items.

### **The following items WILL NOT be picked up:**

- 1) **Vehicle Tires** of any size or type will not be picked up. You may dispose of your tires for a fee at the FMC Landfill located at 3354 330<sup>th</sup> St., Elma, Iowa.
- 2) **Landscape Waste** including grass clippings, leaves, tree limbs or brush. These items are banned from landfills by state law. You may take landscape materials to the Shaw Avenue Yard Waste Disposal Site located off Clark Street and Salsbury Avenue. The site is open seven days per week from sunrise to sunset.  
\*\*City 2017 Brush pick-up dates are: May 1<sup>st</sup>, June 19<sup>th</sup> & October 23<sup>rd</sup>\*\*
- 3) **Hazardous Waste Materials** such as liquid paint, solvents, pesticides, or herbicides. These items must be disposed of at an approved hazardous waste materials collection site. Call the FMC Landfill at 1-877-982-4288 for information on proper disposal.
- 4) **Extra Garbage** placed out after the weekly residential pickup and garbage not in approved collection bags.

The City and Jendro Sanitation have the right to reject any items. If items are not picked up you will be responsible for removing them and properly disposing of them within three (3) days.

**ONLY ITEMS FROM RESIDENTIAL HOMES IN CHARLES CITY WILL BE PICKED UP. ITEMS AT COMMERCIAL BUSINESSES, APARTMENT BUILDINGS AND HOMES WITH FIVE (5) OR MORE APARTMENTS WILL NOT BE PICKED UP. ITEMS MUST ORIGINATE AT THE LOCATION WHERE THEY ARE PICKED UP.**

### **DISPOSAL OF MAJOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT**

MidAmerican Energy's Appliance Recycling program offers rebates to remove qualifying appliances. If your old refrigerator, freezer or window air conditioner is in working condition, you may qualify to have it picked up, properly disposed of and receive a rebate. - Washing machines
- Refrigerators
- Freezers
- Clothes dryers
- Trash compactors
- Dehumidifiers
- Water heaters
- Stoves
- Air conditioners
- Microwave ovens
- Furnaces

The following electronics will incur a fee and can either be taken to the FMC Landfill located at 3354 330<sup>th</sup> St., Elma, Iowa or calling Dave Bock at 641-330-5597 for pickup and amount of fee:

- Televisions
- Computers
- Computer monitors

Rummaging through or removing items placed out for pickup by any person should be done in a neat manner. Only licensed appliance demanufacturers with a valid city permit may dispose of appliances and electronics.
