

2018 Charles City Residential

APRIL 23th, 24th, 25th and 26th

Guidelines

- Each address allowed one pile **2 foot by 8 foot in size up to 3 foot tall**
- Each address allowed one bulky item (couch, mattress & box spring, recliner, etc.)
- Items must be placed curbside no later than 5 a.m. on Monday the 23rd
- Crews will make one initial pass for mattresses and box springs on Monday
- Crews will make one final pass for remaining items Monday-Thursday

Acceptable items for pick up include:

- Furniture & household items
- Minor home remodeling debris – must be bagged, boxed or bundled and weigh less than 50 lbs.
- Paint cans containing dry paints – with lid removed

Non-Acceptable items for pick up include:

- Major Household Appliances, "White goods" , Televisions or Computer Equipment
- Tires
- Shingles, tarpaper or similar materials.
- Landscape Waste: grass clippings, leaves, tree limbs or brush
 - (2018 Brush curbside pickup dates: May 7th, June 25th, October 22nd)
- Hazardous Waste Materials: liquid paint, solvents, pesticides or herbicides.

What not to do:

- Do not place non-acceptable items curbside for pickup
- Items placed curbside prior to Saturday April 21st will be subject to nuisance violation.
- Items placed for pickup must originate from property where they are picked up
- No items from outside City limits will be accepted
- Items in excess of the allowed amount are subject to additional charge
- Do not place items in the alley
- Do not place major appliances, "white goods" or computer equipment curbside

DISPOSAL OF MAJOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

MidAmerican Energy's Appliance Recycling program offers rebates to remove qualifying appliances. If your old refrigerator, freezer or window air conditioner is in working condition, you may qualify to have it picked up, properly disposed of and receive a rebate.
