Spring Cleanup: Two Options

- **Large Self-fill dumpster scheduled pickup: April 12-23 (M-F)**
(Do not bag items)
-OR-
- **Regular Curb-side pickup - April 26-30**
(All non-bulky items must be bagged; do not use orange bags)

Options for item pickup

- **Option 1: "You Fill It" 7'Wx14'Lx4'H** (14.52 cubic yard) dumpster dropped off at your residence; self-filled; pickup 24 hrs. later; no additional charge
 - Call City Hall to schedule drop off 641-257-6300; week of April 12-23**-OR-**
- **Option 2: one pile 2'Wx 8'Lx3'H in size** (1.78 cubic yards) of items bagged. Use any type of regular garbage bag to bag the items for collection, no cardboard boxes allowed. Picked up by City/Jendro; Week of April 26-29
- **Bulky Items:** In addition to options 1 & 2 above, each address allowed two bulky items (couch, mattress & box spring, recliner, etc.) Picked up Monday April 26th

Guidelines

- ****Regular Garbage & Recycling service will be delayed one day from your normal pickup day.****
- Items must be placed curbside no later than Sunday evening April 25th as pickup will begin 5 a.m. Monday morning, and we need to limit person to person contact
- Crews will make a pass for bulky items on Monday; and a final pass for bagged items M-Th.
- We are doing what we can to reduce potential Covid exposure so we appreciate your attention to these new processes for this year.

-OVER-

Acceptable items for pick up include:

- Furniture & household items
- Minor home remodeling debris – must be bagged or bundled (no cardboard boxes allowed) and weigh less than 50 lbs. & must not be longer than 4 foot in length
- Paint cans containing dry paints – with lid removed

Non-Acceptable items for pick up include:

- Major Household Appliances, "White goods", Televisions or Computer Equipment
- Corrugated Cardboard
- Tires / Batteries
- Shingles, tarpaper or construction debris.
- Landscape Waste: grass clippings, leaves, tree limbs or brush
 - (2021 Brush curbside pickup dates: May 10th, June 21st, October 18th)
 - (2021 Leaf pickup dates: October 25th & November 15th)
- Hazardous Waste Materials: liquid paint, solvents, pesticides or herbicides.
- Sharps/Needles/medical Waste

What not to do:

- Do not place non-acceptable items curbside for pickup
- Do not bring items to the curb as crews are picking up. Set them out the day prior.
- Do not place items curbside prior to Saturday April 24th, if done will be a nuisance violation.
- Items placed curbside for pickup must originate from property where they are picked up
- No items from outside City limits will be accepted
- Items in excess of the allowed amount are subject to additional charge
- Do not place items in the alley
- Do not place televisions, major appliances "white goods" or computer equipment curbside

DISPOSAL OF MAJOR HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES & COMPUTER EQUIPMENT

MidAmerican Energy's Appliance Recycling program offers rebates to remove qualifying appliances. If your old refrigerator, freezer or window air conditioner is in working condition, you may qualify to have it picked up, properly disposed of and receive a rebate. The City and Jendro Sanitation retain the right to refuse pickup of any items. Refused items must be properly disposed of by the homeowner/tenant within three (3) days.
